Responsibilities:

The Institute of Crisis Management Studies (ICMS) is looking for a faculty member to teach its "Leadership and Development" module for a four month period. The subject examines leadership development in times of crisis. An emphasis is placed on understanding the key dynamics that influence the way that decision makers perceive and respond to crisis.

The Master’s course currently has a broad range of individuals enrolled including personnel from the Nepalese Army, Police Force and Armed Police, as well as government officials and NGO workers looking to apply skills learned in a practical context. There are possibilities for online lecturing via direct video conference and for individuals to come to Nepal under the remuneration stipulations outlined below.

Course Description:

This course will examine leadership development in times of crisis. An emphasis is placed on understanding the key dynamics that influence the way that decision makers perceive and respond to crises.

Leadership Skills: 6hrs

Crisis Leadership Competency: 6hrs

Leadership: Roles and Responsibilities in Crisis Management: 4hrs

International Leadership - Seven Leaders' Biographies: 10hrs

Public Speaking and Presentation Skill (workshop): 10hrs

Leadership Crisis Simulation: 6hrs
